You will gain exposure to both front-end (HTML, CSS, Javascript) and back-end technologies, primarily in a LAMP (Linux, Apache, MySQL, PHP) development stack. As well as the invaluable on-the-job experience, you will also receive dedicated training built into your work programme.

We're looking for someone who has a genuine interest in improving their skills and furthering their web development career. You do not necessarily need to have commercial experience but should be able to demonstrate some experience with PHP and front-end languages. Whilst training to progress further will be given, having a basic background in web development is crucial.

The role will be based at the British Triathlon headquarters located at Loughborough University; however, the role may very occasionally require evening and weekend working, and associated travel.
