The East Midlands Regional Committee Diversity Co-ordinator is a voluntary position to champion diversity in triathlon regionally.

The position could be combined with another role on the Regional Committee.

Our Diversity Co-ordinator needs to be a passionate advocate for building a more diverse and inclusive sport in the region. As well as supporting local clubs to be more open and inclusive to diverse participants, the Diversity Co-ordinator will also challenge the Regional Committee itself.

Anyone taking on the role will have a fantastic opportunity to increase their skills, develop themselves and help to grow our sport.

We encourage applications from a diverse range of people from all backgrounds and will work to support anyone with additional access requirements.

Key functions of the role	 Attend and contribute to regular meetings of the Regional Committee Lead the equality, diversity and inclusion elements of the Regional Committee's work Contributing Provide support for local clubs and event organisers to build a diverse and inclusive environment Advocate development and learning opportunities for all involved in triathlon regionally Provide assistance and support to colleagues on the Regional Committee in performing their roles

Pre-requisites for the role	 Must be a member of Triathlon England Must be resident in or a member of a club based in the region Must have relevant committee experience
Competencies / Experience required for the role	 Passion for creating a diverse and inclusive environment Knowledge and understanding of equality, diversity and inclusion, particularly within a sporting environment Ability to lead and challenge others with a supportive and collaborative approach Willingness to undertake training and implement policies Passionate about triathlon and developing and growing the sport
Commitment required in the role	 A minimum of four regional meetings annually, plus the AGM Time between meetings to work with other Committee members to progress with actions Contributing to national and regional policies and strategies
Appointment and term of office	 Elected by either an AGM or EGM Two-year term of office with eligibility to stand for re-election
