



Below is a summary of the anti-doping activities carried out by Welsh Triathlon in 2021. With much of the year disrupted due to Covid-19 related challenges we have focused our efforts on working towards meeting the newly introduced UKAD's Assurance Framework, meaning as athlete support and squad delivery returns to a more normal delivery model, we have the strategy and framework in place to ensure Clean Sport is embedded across the sport.

## Clean Sport Education Strategy & Implementation

We have developed a Clean Sport Education strategy which can be found HERE. The purpose of the strategy is to ensure a clean sport triathlon community in Wales. To do this over the next five years we will focus on activities that drive a values based clean sport education approach.

Built upon the UKAD Clean sport curriculum we have identified specific athlete and athlete support personal (ASP) groups within our sporting community and aligned this to relevant education topics.

## Education

All Welsh Triathlon Performance program squad now have a Clean Sport education curriculum and delivery plan, which is being implemented from October 2021 through to September 2022, this will provide Clean Sport Education for ~50 athletes.

All Welsh Triathlon employed coaches and contracted coaches & ASP have completed either the UKAD Coach Clean or Advisor e-learning module.

## Compliance

Welsh Triathlon have submitted evidence for 100% of the UKAD's Assurance framework.
